



COVID-19 Update:

Since the start of COVID-19, KANSEL leadership has kept up or ahead of recommendations to ensure a safe and healthy environment for our students to learn, and our staff to work.

We remained open throughout the spring shut down in a varying capacity, to continue serving and supporting students and testers. On May 4th we reopened the campus with new health and safety protocols that exceeded local health recommendations because we were dedicated to being open and available for our students in a safe way.

The increase locally in both COVID-19 cases, as well as other seasonal illnesses, has dramatically decreased the ability for hospitals to provide local patients care. As a result, our team chose to review what steps needed to be taken, so that a member of our KANSEL family (staff or student) is less likely to be in a position of getting sick while these problems persist.

To date, KANSEL has not been affected by a positive COVID-19 case on our campus. Our students, staff, and guests have done an incredible job of overall complying with sanitizing, washing hands, wearing masks, and not attending classes if they have any symptoms of any illness. In the last week, the data and information available has shown our ability to stay a COVID-19 free campus, as people celebrate throughout the holiday season, is less likely. So as the city, county, and state continue to plan their response, we have chosen to take new proactive precautions that we believe will best keep all students and staff healthy.

Starting Monday, November 23, KANSEL will suspend on-campus learning. This will only affect GED and ESOL on-campus programs until the end of the year, and will return to campus on Monday, January 4th.
